Student Poster Competition

This poster competition will recognize the exceptional research being done in the area of aging. Students are invited to submit an application and display a poster profiling their research project and results at the Centre on Aging's day-long **Applied Research Colloquium (ARC) on March 8, 2012**. This year's colloquium is a part of **IdeaFest**, an initiative of the Office of the Vice-President Research taking place March 5 to 9, 2012.

Eligibility:

Any trainee (undergraduate or graduate student) is eligible to enter.

Submission evaluation criteria:

1. Aligns with and promotes the Centre on Aging's mandate, found at www.coag.uvic.ca/mandate.htm
2. Demonstrates sound research design and methods
3. Reports findings clearly and adds to the body of knowledge on aging

Entries will be adjudicated at the **ARC event on March 8th** by a committee of researchers affiliated with the Centre on Aging.

Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place undergraduate and graduate students will be awarded at the ARC closing event.

Helpful hints for draft submission:

- ↗ Consider carefully what you are trying to convey with this presentation and to whom your presentation is directed.
- ↗ Consider the "What," the "How," and the "Why" of your research, remembering that a poster presentation is primarily a visual medium for conveying information.
- ↗ Keep the material simple, be concise, and avoid jargon.
- ↗ Use only relevant information and be selective when showing results that illustrate the main findings.

Application submission deadline is February 6, 2012.
